To be presented at Stockade Roundup Trial on November 4, 2010

1. Entry deadline is July 5th.
2. Any dog that enters the trial arena during another dogs run will be disqualified. The run in progress will be handled at the discretion of the committee members and judge.
3. Grips are allowed at the judge's discretion.
4. Order of running: Order of will be determined by "drawing for position" by the committee prior to the trials. Bitches in season will run last.
5. Judge's decisions are final.
6. The course director will set the time limit for the trial.
7. The person setting the cattle will signal when the handler can send the dog.
8. The trial is scored on points and time.
9. Each cow through an obstacle is worth one point.
10. Time starts when the dog leaves the mounted handlers side.
11. Time stops when the gate is closed on the pen.
12. Excessive rough handling of the stock or a dog will result in disqualification.
13. Mounted Novice, Mounted Pro Novice and Mounted Open are SSDA Sanctioned
14. Novice, Pro Novice and Open points will qualify for the Lloydminster Top Dog Award.
15. The novice can help their dog through the course - the dog must leave the post before the handler.
16. The Open must remain at the post until the stock passes the plane of the second obstacle
17. Open dogs, all three cows need to go through the obstacles.
18. Re-try of an obstacle is permitted- points are only awarded to cattle successfully cleared on last attempt only- any points from a previous try are lost.
19. Any changes will be addressed by the Judge at the handlers meeting prior to the class.

There will be two runs

Handlers Meeting: Just prior to the trial starting on July 15th.
