RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. A) All animal and bird fanciers are welcome to sell non-utility birds and animals at this sale. No cats or dogs.
B) For the purpose of this sale "non-utility" will be interpreted to mean animals and birds not normally raised and marketed for human food purposes.

2. For the purpose of this Sale we define an "entry" as: a single bird or animal OR a pair as 1 male and 1 female OR a trio as 1 male and 2 females or 3 females, with the **only exception** being pigeons and quail which must be sold as a single, pair or maximum of two pairs per box, no trios. Any one contributor may enter up to a maximum of 15 entries for sale. 3 males cannot be in one box, males must be boxed singly.

The committee makes every effort to enforce that the animals are boxed correctly but it is the responsibility of the consignor to box animals correctly and the buyer to ensure what they are buying is the correct number and gender in the box.

The buyers will be made aware of the rule by announcements from the auction block.

A) All contributors must be sure that their entries are identified and labelled correctly. Any falsely stated entries must be the responsibility of the contributor to either refund or replace said entry at the agreement of both parties. Any buyer who purchases a sale entry that had been defined as a pair or a trio and discovers that such entry is two or three of the same sex, has the right to return the purchase to the seller and receive the proper replacements or receive a refund of sale price.

B) Any seller who does not properly replace or refund sale money will be barred from future sales upon receiving a complaint from the buyer.

C) The owner is required to list the following information legibly written and securely attached to the selling container - owners name and address, telephone number, breed and sex of birds or small animals, and **Game Bird Farm License Number.**

3. **All birds, rabbits, etc. must be presented in a suitable sized container, at least one side with open mesh for buyers to view contents - i.e. good cardboard box with wire screen on one opening, BOTTOMS MUST BE SUITABLY REINFORCED.** Entries will be sold in containers and delivered to buyers. **All large animals must be controllable within standard pen equipment. This rule will be strictly enforced.**

4. Any contributor found guilty of neglecting to attend to an animal entered by him as herein provided may be excluded from future sales by this Association.

5. Upon arrival at the sale premises the Lloydminster Agricultural Exhibition Association at their discretion may have all entries inspected by an inspector designated by the Association, and upon the recommendation of that inspector, the Association shall order the removal from the sale premises any animal having a physical defect, communicable disease, or is inferior in quality or condition.

6. Tampering with entries to hide physical defects is prohibited. This includes surgical alterations, coloration of hair or feathers or any other practice which might misrepresent the animals' true physical characteristics. Offenders will have their entire entry rejected at the discretion of the committee.

7. All contributors to the Rare & Exotic Sale are committed to abide by the Standard Breeder's Guarantee. Individual consignors may provide further guarantees with their offering, by so stating when their offerings are in the sale ring.

8. A) Certain species of Birds and Animals are controlled by:
- 1) **Federal regulations - The Migrating Birds Convention Act**
 - 2) **Alberta Provincial regulations - Wildlife Acts and Regulations**
 - 3) **Saskatchewan Provincial regulations - The Captive Wildlife Regulation**
- B) Any persons wishing to sell, buy or show, birds or animals controlled by the above acts may require an import or an export permit as the case may be.
- C) All contributors and buyers are required to make themselves aware of the requirements of the above acts and obtain the necessary permits as needed and abide by the regulations governing the acquisition and sale of any controlled bird or animal. It is the responsibility of each person to contact their local Wildlife Management Office to determine if they require any permits, etc.
- D) Permits and Game Bird License numbers must be clearly attached or legibly written on sale container.
9. There will be a sale entry fee of **\$3.50, G.S.T. INCLUDED**, per box or entry, **entry fee must accompany sale entry form or the entry will be considered a post entry.** Entry forms must be received and entry fee paid by 5:00 p.m. Friday, APRIL 9th to be classified as a pre-entry. Any entries received after 5:00 p.m. are classified as a post-entry. See rule #15 (B) for contributor selling order.
10. ALL SALES COMMISSION ARE SUBJECT TO 5% G.S.T.
Sale Commission will be:
- A) No sale commission will be charged on the first \$15.00 of sale price per entry.
- B) Animals or birds with a selling price of \$15.01 up to \$99.99 per entry will have a 20% sale commission deducted per entry.
- C) Animals or birds with a selling price of \$100.00 and up per entry will have a 10% sale commission deducted per entry.
11. A Consignor may not remove his entry from the sale once it has been lot numbered unless asked to do so by the committee in charge.
12. **No Sale and Buy Backs by contributors will be charged full commission. Absolutely no reserved bids. This rule will be strictly enforced.**
13. **Sale payout will be forwarded via mail 3 weeks following the sale, NOT ON SALE DAY.**
14. Information for the breeder's directory must be received by 5:00 p.m. April 3, 2009 Anyone who purchases a sale entry will receive one free copy of the directory.
15. A) **All sale entries must be in sale barn by 10:00 A.M. on sale day.**
To start the sale the committee will be selecting 10 boxes, from the pre or post entries. These 10 boxes will start the sale, followed by the pre-entered boxes in lot number, followed by the post entries in lot number. This segment does not included large animals.

The sale order change from boxes to livestock will be at discretion of the committee.
(Approximately 2:00 p.m. local time)

Pre-entered (boxes) lots will be numbered as entries (boxes) are received in sale facility the day of the sale. Lots (boxes) not entered prior to sale day and brought in on sale day morning will be numbered as they are received in the sale facility.

LARGE ANIMALS

Large animals will be lot numbered as they arrive at the sale day morning. Large animals will be sold in lot number.

- C) All large animals will be sold at approximately 2:00 P.M. local time.
16. All contributors of large animals requiring a brand manifest must present a brand manifest upon entering the sale barn. **All sheep and lambs that arrive must have the mandatory PINK CSIP tag as per CFIA program. The animals that require RFID Tags must abide by all CCIA rules & regulations.**
17. If a sale entry is registered, the tattoo letters must be distinct and easily readable and must coincide exactly with registration papers or the animal will be rejected from the sale. A copy of the registration papers must be provided with the sale entry. **Contributors of any stock being sold as purebred and registered are responsible for their own transfer of registration papers at the contributor's expense.**
18. A) Contributors of large animals will be required to place their animals in display pens and remain with their entry and maintain control of this entry at all times for the safety of the general public.
B) **Contributors of large animals will be responsible to lead their entry into the sale ring and return it to its stall following the sale. ALL LARGE ANIMALS MUST HAVE A HALTER ON AND THE HALTER MUST REMAIN WITH THE ANIMAL AT ALL TIMES.**
C) **IF THE CONTRIBUTOR REMOVES THE HALTER AND/OR NECK ROPE; THE COMMITTEE WILL SUPPLY A HALTER AND/OR NECK ROPE AND THE COST WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE CONTRIBUTORS SETTLEMENT.** This requirement is to assure the safety of the general public and buyers. Any contributor who fails to present their entry in the sale ring may not have their entry sold, at the discretion of the Committee.
D) **Contributors of large animals will not be allowed to bid in the sale ring when their entries are being sold.**
E) **Contributors of large animals may submit a 25 word or less description of their sale entry to the auctioneer, which he may read at his discretion. Contributors may not make verbal comments over the microphone.**
19. The Association acts as an agent only and the Association will not accept financial responsibility between buyer and seller under any circumstance.
20. ASSOCIATION IS AGENT ONLY: It is clearly understood that the Association is only acting as a medium between buyer and seller and is not in anyway responsible for any failure on the part of either party to live up to his obligations to collect or enforce collection of any money between parties. Any legal action that may, in exceptional cases, be taken must be between buyer and seller themselves. In all cases, however, the influence of the Association will be exerted, as far as possible, to hold all parties strictly to these regulations.
21. Every care will be exercised by the management to prevent injury or loss of property, but the Association, acting only as medium between the buyer and seller, will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, whether through negligence on the part of its officers or servants or not. Insurance against loss should be taken out by the owner, if he considers it necessary.
22. Immediately after each purchase is declared, the risk of the entry shall be exclusively with the purchaser.
23. The Committee reserves the Right to refuse or accept or limit any entries for the betterment of the sale.
24. Every person who contributes an entry to the sale agrees to the foregoing terms and conditions.
25. The Golden Feather & Fur, Rare & Exotic Sale Committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules, which said Committee, considers is necessary for the proper regulation and management of the sale.
26. Notwithstanding to the contrary anything herein contained, it is understood that each entrant, by the act of entry or exhibiting, waives all claims against the Lloydminster Agricultural Exhibition Association Ltd., and/or any of the members, officers, or agents thereof, for any and all injury, loss or damage which he, his employees, helpers and/or property may sustain arising in any way out of the operation or activities of the said Associations officers, members or agents and indemnifies the said Association, officers, members or agents from and against any loss or damage sustained by the said Association by reason of any claim made by any of his helpers or assistants introduced to or engaged by any entrant through the said Association or any of them through their members, officers or agents shall be at the sole risk and responsibility of such entrant.
